
Call for Papers

Eleven Persons from Eight Countries Join the Global Seismological Observation Course for Two **Months**

The Opening Ceremony of the Global Seismological Observation Training Course was held at the JICA Tsukuba from 11:30 to 12:00 on Tuesday, January 20 2015. The training participants from China, Egypt (2), Iran, Nepal (2), Pakistan (2), Solomon Islands, and Thailand came to Japan and joined the ceremony. Although a participant from Papua New Guinea was late to come to Japan and could not attend the ceremony, he arrived in Japan at the end of the week and now he joins the course actively.

In the ceremony, we had two special guests, Dr. Nurcan Meral-Özel, Director of the Monitoring System International (IMS) Division of Provisional Technical the Secretariat (PTS) of the Preparatory Commission for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization (CTBTO) from Vienna, Austria, and Mr. Hideaki Ishii, Principal Deputy Director of Arms Control and Disarmament Division, Disarmament, Non-Proliferation and Science Department,

Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (MOFA). Dr. Meral-Özel gave the first lecture to the participants on the Overview on International Monitoring System on that day.

The Global Seismological Observation Training Course has the special aim to develop human resources having acquired the skills necessary for detecting nuclear tests applying seismological knowledge. We need the support and cooperation with CTBTO, MOFA, JICA, Japan Meteorological Agency and other organizations concerned in order to carry out this training program.

After the quests' addresses, Dr. Yuzo Sakamoto, BRI Chief Executive and Mr. Senichi, Director General of JICA Tsukuba made their welcome speeches.

Finally, as the representative of the participants, Mr. Bharat Prasad Koirala from Nepal gave an address in reply. Although the course period is short, we hope that they will be actively engaged in the



training program and take good memories to their home. As usual we wish to give them the welcome words, "Where there's a will, there's a way."
